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Certification of Pool/Spa Anti-Entrapment Cover Installation

Effective January 1, 2007, Swimming Pool and Safety Act of 2006 (Assembly Bill 2977) requires the following:

Whenever a building permit is issued for the construction, remodel or modification of a swimming pool, toddler pool, or spa, the permit shall require that the suction outlet(s) of the swimming pool, toddler pool or spa be upgraded so as to be equipped with an anti-entrapment cover meeting current standards of the American Society for Testing and Materials or the American Society of Mechanical Engineers (ASME/ANSI A112.19.8). The following embossed or permanently marked logo or verbiage must be in a location that is visible when installed:



Or:

**“ASME A112.19.8 2007”, Flow Rating “X GPM”,
“Life: X Years”, and Manufacturer and Model**

An inspection is required to verify compliance with the above noted requirement prior to final approval. If there is water in the existing swimming pool, toddler pool or spa, the required inspection and verification cannot be performed. Instead of requiring the property owner to empty the swimming pool, toddler pool or spa, the property owner may choose to complete and sign the certificate below attesting compliance with the above noted requirement.
