The City of Oceanside invites public comments as it prepares two separate five-year programs of planned capital improvement projects:

The first is the City's own spending plan, which includes new or improved facilities of all kinds, including roads, bikeways, parks, municipal buildings, harbor and beach improvements, storm drains, water supply and sewage collection infrastructure.

The second is Oceanside's portion of the Regional Transportation Improvement Program (RTIP), which is the San Diego region's program of proposed major highway, arterial roadway, transit, and bikeway projects funded by TransNet sales tax revenue, State and Federal programs, as well as development fees collected by cities and the County of San Diego for regional arterial roads.
