GETTING STARTED

How do I get a Beach Cruiser?

Visit Parks & Recreation at 300 North Coast Highway to register. You will be asked to provide a valid Driver's License or State issued identification card, a working cellular phone number and you will need to sign a liability waiver form.

There is a \$5.00 rental fee.

Once registered you will be given a key to a designated locker and Beach Cruiser.

NOTE: Bikes are available on a first come first served basis and you will have to register every time you want to rent a bicycle.

Using the Oceanside Beach Cruisers

The Oceanside Beach Cruisers are quality TREK Cruiser Bikes. They need special care to ensure they last and that many riders can safely enjoy them for years to come. Please follow the following steps when using a Beach Cruiser.

Inspect the Bike

Look for damage, flattened tires or other visible signs that the bike needs some TLC.

If you find a bike in need of repair please notify Parks & Recreation staff by calling (760) 435-5041.

Remember, Safety First

When you are riding an Oceanside Beach Cruiser please observe all the "rules of the road" and be aware of traffic and other distractions. Be a safe and cautious rider, especially when riding with children!

Helmets are required for children under 18 years of age. (CA state law)
