ALUMINUM, BI METAL & TIN CANS

- Aluminum beverage cans
- Tin Cans (i.e. canned vegetables & soups)

GLASS

- Beverage bottles (ALL colors)
 - Food jars (i.e. sauces & pickles)
- NO DISHES, DRINKING GLASSES, LIGHT BULBS, WINDOWS OR MIRRORS

PLASTIC (NO plastic bags!)

- Plastic beverage containers with recycling symbols numbered 1–7
- Empty Bottles from household cleaners with recycling symbols numbered 1–7 (i.e. shampoo, laundry detergent, window cleaners, etc.)

Any CRV Material (California Redemption Value)

PAPER AND CARDBOARD

- Newspaper, mixed paper (all colors), cardboard
- Catalogs, magazines, telephone books, shoe boxes, cereal boxes (remove liners)
- Any color computer/fax paper, junk mail, paper bags and flattened cardboard

GREEN WASTE

Yard waste such as grass clippings, leaves, weeds and other prunings. Prunings and branches must be tied into 4-foot sections into bundles not to exceed 18 inches in diameter. DO NOT use wire for bundles. Please use string. Place green waste cart on the curb by 6 a.m. on your regular trash day. **DO NOT USE PLASTIC BAGS.** Green waste in plastic bags will not be collected.
