INSTRUCTIONS

This contest is for Oceanside students in grades kindergarten through 5th. Complete the entry information at the bottom and use the back of this page for your drawing (size not to exceed 8-1/2" x 11"). Then submit your completed entry form to your teacher or the mailing address below, with your art work included on the back. The following information must be included with each entry: name, address, phone number, school, grade, teacher's name and contact information, and grade category. Teachers can submit classroom entries in person or by mail. The contest deadline is **Monday, April 2, 2012**. The theme “GREEN OCEANSIDE” can be used to brainstorm clever ideas for your poster, incorporating: Reduce, Reuse, Recycle...Zero Waste....Water Conservation... and/or Water Pollution Prevention. Acceptable materials: pencil, ink, crayons, felt-tip pens, paint, or collage. No computer generated artwork will be accepted. Do not copy or reproduce trademark or character designs. Original reproductions will not be accepted. You must use the back of this entry form for your artwork. All entries must be individual (group entries will not be accepted).

Finalist entries may be on display at the Green Fair on Saturday, April 28, 2012, from 11PM to 4PM at the Pier Amphitheater. Students, parents, teachers and guests are encouraged to attend!

RULES

To be eligible, students must live in Oceanside or attend an Oceanside Unified School District school. Proof may be required. Only original artwork will be accepted. All entries will be judged on best expression of contest theme, creativity, grammar and grade level skill. Contest sponsors and agencies will not be responsible for lost, stolen, illegible or misdirected entries. BY ENTERING CONTEST, ENTRANT ACCEPTS AND AGREES TO ABOVE LISTED RULES. THE DECISION OF THE JUDGES IS FINAL.

All finalists will be notified by telephone, mail and/or by their teacher(s). There will be one 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winner from each age category. Grand prize winners and top finalists will be awarded at the Green Fair on Saturday, April 28, 2012, at the Beach Amphitheater between 11am-4pm. Awards include: gift cards to local establishments, 'green' school supplies and/or award certificates.
