

## Oceanside Youth Scholarship Program

### FAQs:

#### **How can I apply for a scholarship?**

- (1) Submit online through [Recadmin@ci.oceanside.ca.us](mailto:Recadmin@ci.oceanside.ca.us)
  - (2) Print out the application and mail to:

  - (3) Come in person to the Parks and Recreation office
- \*All applications and scholarship enrollments are processed at the Parks and Recreation Administration office ONLY!**

#### **What do I need to provide?**

- (1) Proof of residency
- (2) Birth Certificate(s)
- (3) If your child receives the free/reduced lunch program at an Oceanside or Vista Unified School you will need to provide the qualification letter from that school.
- (4) If your child is not participating in the free/reduced lunch program at school, then you will need to supply the last two current pay stubs to prove your monthly income and/or the current tax year filed.

#### **If I am on Section 8 do I automatically qualify?**

No, not necessarily.

#### **Do I have to be an Oceanside resident?**

Yes, only Oceanside residents are eligible for the Youth Scholarship Program.

#### **Can I receive a 100% scholarship?**

There is **NO** 100% qualification. A family will be responsible for paying 50% of each program a child enrolls in.

#### **How much money can I receive?**

A qualifying family can use up to \$150.00 for the whole fiscal year, per family, regardless of the number of children. (while funds are available)

#### **When are applications accepted?**

Applications are accepted starting July 1<sup>st</sup> and expire June 30<sup>th</sup> of the following year or until funds run out, whichever occurs first.

#### **What is the most I could receive annually?**

The top fixed dollar amount is \$150.00 per family. (while funds are available)

#### **Can I roll it over? What if I don't use it?**

Applicants who do not use all the scholarship monies will not be able to carry them forward but they can reapply the next fiscal year (July 1<sup>st</sup>).
