

VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE

June 5, 2012 Special Municipal Election

There will be a Special Municipal Election held on Tuesday, June 5, 2012. The City of Oceanside will have a City Measure on whether to adopt Ordinance No. 11-OR0427-1, adding Section 16B16(e) to the Oceanside City Code for the purpose of implementing vacancy decontrol allowing space rents to increase to market value following the sale or conveyance of a manufactured home. In order to cast your vote, you must be registered to vote by **May 21, 2012**.

You must register to vote if you are not currently registered, if you have recently moved into the City of Oceanside or if you recently turned 18 years of age. You must re-register to vote if you have changed your name or your address within the City (even if you only moved across the street).

Voter registration cards can be picked up at the City Clerk's Office at 300 North Coast Highway in Oceanside. Or, you can call us at 760-435-3000, and we will gladly mail one to you. The cards are pre-addressed and stamped for your convenience. Just fill out the form, sign it (husbands and wives *cannot* sign for each other) and mail it in.

Voting is a wonderful privilege and a responsibility. It is an opportunity to vote for the candidates that best exemplify the desired qualifications, goals and vision for our City. Your vote does count. So remember to register to be eligible to vote in the upcoming local elections!
