

OCEANSIDE'S SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION
TUESDAY, JUNE 5, 2012
CALENDAR REGARDING BALLOT MEASURE ARGUMENTS

On Tuesday, June 5, 2012, two ballot measures will be submitted to the voters on 1) Proposition E - whether to adopt Ordinance No. 11-OR0427-1, adding Section 16B16(e) to the Oceanside City Code for the purpose of implementing vacancy decontrol allowing space rents to increase following the sale or conveyance of a manufactured home, and 2) Proposition F - whether to adopt the proposed amendment to the Charter of the City of Oceanside to establish numbered, elected at-large seats, effective upon passage; establish June first-round election, and a November runoff election for any June election where no candidate receives 50%+1 for all elected offices, effective for the June 2014 election; establish a first-round election and runoff election if no candidate receives 50%+1 for any special election to fill a vacancy or recall election, effective upon passage.

June 5	Election Day Polls Open 7:00 AM to 8:00 PM
