FILING OF COMMITTEE CAMPAIGN DISCLOSURE STATEMENTS FOR June 5, 2012

In compliance with the Political Reform Act, Sections 84200.7(b) and 84204, all candidates/committees must file Campaign Statements at various stages of the election process. For your information, these regular deadlines are as follows:

March 22, 2012 May 24, 2012 July 31, 2012

PERIOD COVERED

January 1 – March 17, 2012 March 18 – May 19, 2012 May 20 – June 30, 2012

THESE FILINGS MUST BE IN THE CITY CLERK'S OFFICE BY THE DEADLINE DATES LISTED

Late filings of campaign statements are subject to penalties and fines, which accrue at the rate of \$10.00 per day, starting the day after the filing deadline until the statement or report is filed with the City Clerk. The maximum penalty is \$100 or the total amount of contributions received or expenditures made (whichever is greater) during the period covered by the late statement.

It is important that you read all information on campaign disclosure carefully and comply with the instructions for proper reporting and timely filing of your campaign statements. ³ A controlled committee of a candidate may not make an independent expenditure to support or oppose another candidate (Gov. Code § 85501).
