A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OCEANSIDE RATIFYING
PROCLAMATION OF LOCAL EMERGENCY BY THE DIRECTOR OF EMERGENCY SERVICES

PROCLAMATION OF EXISTENCE OF A LOCAL EMERGENCY
BY THE DIRECTOR OF EMERGENCY SERVICES

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 73-22 of the City of Oceanside Municipal Code empowers the Director of Emergency Services to proclaim the existence or threatened existence of a local emergency when said City is affected or likely to be affected by a public calamity and the City Council is not in session; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Emergency Services of the City of Oceanside does hereby find:

That conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property
have arisen within said City, caused by:
Damage as a result of heavy rainfall and flooding, including but not limited to
a rupture of the Haymar sewer line in the Buena Vista Creek bed

and

That the City Council of the City of Oceanside is not in
session (and cannot immediately be called into session);

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby proclaimed that a local emergency now exists
throughout the said City; and

IT IS FURTHER proclaimed and ordered that during the existence of said local
emergency the powers, functions, and duties of the emergency organization of this City
shall be those prescribed by State law, by Municipal Code, Ordinances, and Resolutions
of this City, and by the City of Oceanside Emergency Plan, as approved by City Council
on May 15, 2002.
