AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OCEANSIDE RESCINDING ORDINANCE 07-OR0369-1 REGARDING CITY COUNCIL SALARIES AND AMENDING SECTION 2.1.70 OF THE OCEANSIDE CITY CODE TO ADJUST THE SALARY FOR MEMBERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF SECTIONS 36516 AND 36516.5 OF THE CALIFORNIA GOVERNMENT CODE

WHEREAS, Oceanside City Code section 2.1.70 establishes the salary of the members of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, in 2007 City Council adopted Ordinance No. 07-OR0369-1 reestablishing the salary of the members of the City Council at the current amount of \$1,467.86 per month; and

WHEREAS, the City Council now wishes to rescind Ordinance No. 07-OR0369-1 and replace it with this current ordinance; and

WHEREAS, Oceanside City Ordinance No. 85-26 established additional compensation for the Mayor of \$150.00 per month; and

WHEREAS, Government Code section 36516 establishes a formula for making adjustments to the salary paid to members of a city council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to adjust the salary paid to members of the Oceanside City Council as authorized by the Government Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Oceanside does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 07-OR0369-1 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 2. Section 2.1.70 of the Oceanside City Code is amended by the amendment of subsection (a) to read as follows:

“(a) *Salary*. From and after the commencement of the first regular pay period following the date established pursuant to subsection (b) the members of the City Council shall receive a salary of \$1,644.00 per month in accordance with the provisions of Section 36516 of the California Government Code.”

“(b) The City Council may by ordinance adjust the salary of its members

1 pursuant to Government Code Section 36516 provided however that any adjustment to increase  
2 the salary shall become payable only on and after the date upon which one or more members of  
3 the council becomes eligible therefore by virtue of beginning a new term of office following the  
4 next succeeding general municipal election held in the city, and then all members of the council  
5 shall be entitled to the adjustment.

6 SECTION 3. Within fifteen (15) days after its passage, the City Clerk shall cause this  
7 ordinance to be published pursuant to the provisions of California Government Code section  
8 36933.

9 SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be effective thirty (30) days after its adoption.
