SUBJECT: **AWARD OF CONTRACT FOR THE FY 2006-07 ANNUAL STREET RESTORATION AND OVERLAY PROJECT**

SYNOPSIS

Staff recommends that the City Council award a contract in the amount of \$1,369,000 to Hardy and Harper, Inc., Santa Ana for the FY 2006-07 Annual Street Restoration and Overlay Project, and authorize the City Manager to execute the agreement upon receipt of all supporting documents.

BACKGROUND

Each fiscal year, a construction contract for the replacement and restoration of surface streets and other asphalt-related items is developed as part of an ongoing program aimed at improving public roadways.

On June 20, 2007, the City Council approved the plans and specifications and authorized a call for bids for the project. Notices inviting sealed bids were sent to qualified area contractors and were also advertised in local newspapers and trade journals in accordance with City's standard bidding procedures.

ANALYSIS

This contract proposes to restore asphalt paving at various locations throughout the City. Restoration needs for these projects were determined by citizen reports of deteriorating asphalt and related items, and staff's review to determine high priorities for restoration.

The bids were publicly opened on August 30, 2007. Nine bids were received, as listed, and the lowest responsible bidder is Hardy and Harper of Santa Ana with a bid of \$1,369,000. The successful bidder's credentials have been researched and found to meet City requirements.

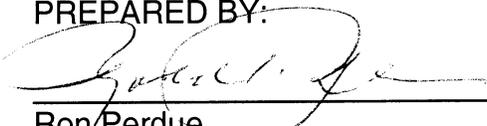

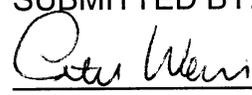

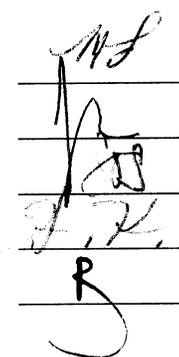
