SUBJECT: **APPROVAL OF PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE ANNUAL SLURRY SEAL FY 2005-06 PROJECT AND AUTHORIZATION FOR THE CITY ENGINEER TO CALL FOR BIDS**

## **SYNOPSIS**

Staff recommends that the City Council approve the plans and specifications for the Annual Slurry Seal FY 2005-06 project and authorize the City Engineer to call for bids.

## **BACKGROUND**

Each fiscal year, a maintenance contract for restoration of City streets is offered for competitive bid. The restoration project is part of an ongoing program based on the five-year Pavement Management Plan to restore and preserve the City's streets.

## **ANALYSIS**

This project will apply minor street restoration techniques to 13 lane miles located on seven (7) street segments Citywide as shown in Exhibit A, which includes the removal and replacement of deteriorated sections of streets, crack-sealing and the application of a Rubberized Emulsified Aggregate Slurry, which will provide a flexible, new wearing surface to the street that will extend the useful life of the street and delay the need for costly major restorations.

## **FISCAL IMPACT**

The FY 2005-06 Capital Improvement Program appropriation for the total street restoration program is \$1,541,000 in Gas Tax Funds. The estimated total cost, which includes administration, inspection, project management and contingencies, is \$758,895. Sufficient funds are available for this project.

## **INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS**

The City's standard insurance requirements will be provided.


**CITY ATTORNEY'S ANALYSIS**
