SUBJECT: **RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING STOP CONTROL ON CORONA DRIVE  
AT ALAMOSA PARK DRIVE**

**SYNOPSIS**

Staff and the Transportation Commission recommend that the City Council adopt a resolution establishing a stop control on Corona Drive at Alamosa Park Drive.

**BACKGROUND**

Alamosa Park Elementary School is located along Alamosa Park Drive, southeast of the intersection of Corona Drive and Alamosa Park Drive. The City received a request from the PTA Safety and Wellness Chairman requesting a painted crosswalk on Corona Drive at Alamosa Park Drive. This is a primary route for school children in the neighborhood.

**ANALYSIS**

North Santa Fe Avenue is the main access point for Alamosa Park Drive. Corona Drive intersects Alamosa Park Drive to form a "T" intersection and serves the residential area west of Alamosa Park Drive. There is no stop control at this intersection. School children walking along Alamosa Park Drive currently cross Corona Drive without any crosswalk or traffic control device.

Alamosa Park Drive is the main entrance to Alamosa Park Elementary School. There is an existing yellow school crosswalk on the northwest corner of the intersection of Alamosa Park Drive and Pinewood Drive (see Exhibit A). To be consistent with traffic patterns in the area, staff recommends the establishment of a stop control on Corona Drive at Alamosa Park Drive. A yellow crosswalk will also be installed on Corona Drive at Alamosa Park Drive.

**FISCAL IMPACT**

The installation of the proposed stop sign and crosswalk would cost approximately \$400 with an increase in annual maintenance of one work hour.

**CITY ATTORNEY'S ANALYSIS**

The referenced documents have been reviewed by the City Attorney and approved as the form.

**COMMISSION OR COMMITTEE REPORT**

At their January 20, 2009, meeting the Transportation Commission approved the proposed stop sign.

**RECOMMENDATION**

Staff and the Transportation Commission recommend that the City Council adopt a resolution establishing a stop control on Corona Drive at Alamosa Park Drive.




