SUBJECT: **ADOPTION OF A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE ANNUAL BEACH PARKING PERMIT PROGRAM**

## **SYNOPSIS**

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt a resolution amending the City's Annual Beach Parking Permit Program to include a transferable permit option.

## **BACKGROUND**

The Annual Beach Parking Permit Program was established by the City Council on April 17, 1991, and was modified in 1994 setting the fee for the permit at \$100. Currently, the Annual Beach Permit is issued to a specific vehicle and is permanently affixed to the vehicle. The cost of the permit is \$100 and is valid from July 1 through June 30.

## **ANALYSIS**

The City Council has expressed an interest in having the permits be transferable. Based on the Council's direction on February 8, 2006, staff is recommending that permanent permits be retained and a transferable option be made available to the community.

**Transferable Permit Option:** Residents will have the option of purchasing a transferable permit. Once issued, the transferable permit would be fully transferable to any vehicle. The permit will only be replaced with the purchase of a new permit. If the permit is misplaced, lost or stolen, a new permit must be purchased.

**Cost:** The cost of the permit would be retained at \$100 per year. The permit will be valid from July 1 to June 30 and the cost of the permit will be prorated at a cost of \$10 per month on a monthly basis based on the month of purchase.

Enforcement: Vehicles would need to display the transferable permit in order to avoid a citation. If a resident has been issued a permit, but has failed to display the permit, the vehicle will be subject to a citation. Failure to display the permit will not be a valid reason to avoid a citation, or having an issued citation dismissed.

**FISCAL IMPACT**

The City currently issues 560 permits per year for a total of \$56,000 per year. The actual impact cannot be determined at this time. The administrative costs will be recovered in the cost of issuing the permits. The loss of revenue as a result of the residents using the permits rather than paying each time for parking is expected to be negligible.

4 PARKING PERMIT PROGRAM

5 WHEREAS, it has been determined that it is in the public interest to modify the annual  
6 parking permit for Municipal Parking Lot Nos. 7, 10, 11A, 11B, 12, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26,  
7 27, 28, 29, 30 and 31.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Oceanside does resolve as follows:

9 Effective March 1, 2006, the annual parking permit program shall be modified by  
10 rescinding Resolution No. R94-121 and amending Section 4 of Resolution No. R93-147 to  
11 read:

12 4. An annual parking permit may be purchased for Municipal Parking Lot Nos. 7,  
13 10, 11A, 11B, 12, 21, 22, 23, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31 and 24 for an annual fee of \$100.00.  
14 The permit shall be valid in lot 24 only from 9 p.m. to 9 a.m. The permit shall not authorize  
15 parking at any time in Parking Lot No. 20, nor at street parking meters. The permit shall not  
16 authorize overnight parking in Municipal parking lots. The permit shall be valid between July  
17 1 of one year to June 30 of the next year. The cost of the permit shall be prorated on a monthly  
18 basis, at a cost of \$10/month based on the date it is issued. There shall be no limit on the  
19 number of permits sold.


