AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OCEANSIDE AMENDING CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE I, SECTION 2.1.64(d) OF THE OCEANSIDE CITY CODE REGARDING APPOINTMENTS TO CITY BOARDS, COMMISSIONS OR COMMITTEES

WHEREAS, Section 2.1.64 of the Oceanside City Code generally regulates appointments to City boards, commissions and committees in accordance with relevant provisions of California state law; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting of February 20, 2008, the City Council expressed its desire to receive the names of the mayor’s nominees to city boards commission and committees prior to the council meeting at which the nomination will be considered;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Oceanside does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Subdivision (d) of Section 2.1.64 of the Oceanside City Code is amended to read as follows:

“Whenever the mayor intends to make an appointment to fill a scheduled or unscheduled vacancy in a city board, commission, or committee, the mayor shall give written notice to the city clerk and city council. The city clerk shall forthwith provide to the mayor and to each member of the city council all active applications filed with the clerk for appointment to the position or positions stated in the notice from the mayor. The mayor shall not make an appointment until after the passage of fourteen (14) days from the date the mayor delivers the notice of intent to the city clerk and city council. Any member of the council may make recommendation to the mayor regarding an appointment. Appointments shall be made only at a regular or adjourned meeting of the city council. The mayor shall provide to the council the name of the nominee at least seventy-two (72) hours before the meeting at which the appointment will be considered by the city council. Appointments by the mayor are subject to the approval by the city council, including the mayor.”

SECTION 2. The City Clerk of the City of Oceanside is hereby directed to publish this ordinance, or the title hereof as a summary, pursuant to state statute, once within fifteen (15) days after its passage in the North County Times, a newspaper of general circulation published

1 in the City of Oceanside.

2 SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth (30<sup>th</sup>) day  
3 from and after its final passage.


