SUBJECT: **ADOPTION OF A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING ALL-WAY STOP CONTROLS AT THE INTERSECTION OF TYLER AND MCKINLEY STREETS**

SYNOPSIS

Staff and the Transportation Commission recommend that the City Council adopt a resolution establishing all-way stop controls at the intersection of Tyler and McKinley Streets.

BACKGROUND

Staff has received a petition from Ms. Pauline Darwin of 4960 Tyler Street requesting traffic-calming measures on Tyler Street. The neighborhood had been working with previous transportation staff on methods to reduce speeding on Tyler Street.

ANALYSIS

Tyler Street is classified as a two-lane residential street with a 25 mph speed limit. McKinley Street is classified as a two-lane residential street and connects to the adjacent neighborhood. The location is a four-way intersection with stop controls on McKinley Street (see Exhibit A).

The average daily traffic (ADT) count for Tyler Street at McKinley Street is approximately 400 vehicles per day for both directions. The ADT for McKinley Street is approximately 1,200 vehicles per day. The critical speed (the speed at which 85 percent of vehicles are traveling, or below) is 26 mph for both directions on Tyler Street.

Accident history was reviewed and there have been two reported accidents (rear-end and sideswipe) in the last five years from 2002 to 2006 at this location.

The proposed stop controls will help assign the right-of-way for pedestrians and vehicles using the intersection and reduce vehicle speeds on Tyler Street

Based on traffic-calming strategies, staff recommends the installation of all-way stop controls.

FISCAL IMPACT

The installation of the proposed stop signs would cost approximately \$400 with an increase in annual maintenance of two workhours.

COMMISSION OR COMMITTEE REPORT

At its December 19, 2006 meeting, the Transportation Commission reviewed and approved the proposed stops.

CITY ATTORNEY'S ANALYSIS

The resolution has been reviewed by the City Attorney and approved as to form.

RECOMMENDATION


Staff and the Transportation Commission recommend that the City Council adopt a resolution establishing all-way stop controls at the intersection of Tyler and McKinley Streets.


PETITION REQUESTING TRAFFIC CALMING MEASURES


