SUBJECT: **APPROVAL OF PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE MAPLE DRIVE AT SUNBURST DRIVE STORM DRAIN PROJECT; AND AUTHORIZATION FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR TO CALL FOR BIDS**

SYNOPSIS

Staff recommends that the City Council approve the plans and specifications for the Maple Drive at Sunburst Drive Storm Drain project and authorize the Public Works Director to call for bids.

BACKGROUND

Maple Drive is damaged by continuous groundwater runoff. The runoff supports the growth of algae and damages concrete in the cross gutter at Sunburst Drive, thus creating a potentially hazardous condition.

ANALYSIS

The long-term exposure to the groundwater runoff has caused multiple pavement failures along Maple Drive. Further, the algae in the cross gutter cannot be controlled until the flow of water is curtailed.

This project will intercept the groundwater as it enters the gutter, remove excess water from the base section of the street and convey it to an existing storm drain. This project will also reconstruct the damaged cross gutter at Maple Drive and Sunburst Drive.

FISCAL IMPACT

The total estimated project cost, including design, project management, inspection and construction is \$95,000. Sufficient funds in the amount of \$100,000 are available in the CIP project account.

INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

The City's standard insurance requirements will be met.




