SUBJECT: **APPROVAL OF PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE INDUSTRY STREET RECONSTRUCTION; AND AUTHORIZATION FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR TO CALL FOR BIDS**

SYNOPSIS

Staff recommends that the City Council approve the plans and specifications for the Industry Street Reconstruction project and authorize the Public Works Director to call for bids.

BACKGROUND

While Industry Street was reconstructed over thirty years ago, it is located in an area of weak soils and is subjected to extremely heavy traffic

ANALYSIS

Industry Street, a collector street that serves an industrial section of the City of Oceanside is in poor condition due to its age, industrial truck traffic and poor soils in the area. The project will reconstruct Industry Street from Oceanside Boulevard to a point west of Camelot Drive.

FISCAL IMPACT

The total estimated project cost, including design, project management, inspection and construction is \$434,000. Sufficient funds in the amount of \$456,000 are available in the Streets/Transnet account effective July 1, 2006.

INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

The City's standard insurance requirements will be met.


CITY ATTORNEY'S ANALYSIS
