SUBJECT: **PRESENTATION ON THE FULL ACCESS AND COORDINATED
TRANSPORTATION (FACT)**

SYNOPSIS

The vision statement of Full Access and Coordinated Transportation (FACT) is to provide all San Diego County residents with full mobility within their community through an accessible transportation system that meets the needs of the individuals.

BACKGROUND

Coordinated transportation is a system that integrates human service agencies that provide transportation with public and private transit providers. This system creates the most efficient use of limited transportation resources by avoiding the duplication caused by overlapping individual program efforts and encouraging the use and sharing of existing community resources.

FACT envisions the need to have a centralized dispatching system for all transportation service providers for public, private and volunteer programs. This new program will be a centralized "one number to call" system. Residents needing to travel in the County can then call this one number to schedule and arrange transportation.

Under this new program, the transportation providers will overcome perceived barriers in services and pool their resources to meet the needs of the communities within San Diego County.




