SUBJECT: **REQUEST FOR APPROVAL OF A TEMPORARY STREET CLOSURE OF PACIFIC STREET FROM SEAGAZE DRIVE TO PIER VIEW WAY AND MISSION AVENUE FROM MYERS STREET TO PACIFIC STREET, FROM 8:00 A.M. TO MIDNIGHT ON MAY 13, 2006, JUNE 25, 2006, AUGUST 13, 2006, AND OCTOBER 8, 2006, FOR THE JEFFERSON PILOT COMMUNICATIONS COUNTRYFEST NORTH AND THE SMOOTH JAZZ 98.1 JAZZ ON THE BEACH CONCERTS AT THE PIER AMPHITHEATER**

SYNOPSIS

Staff recommends that City Council approve Jefferson Pilot Communications' request for the temporary street closure of Pacific Street from Seagaze Drive to Pier View Way and Mission Avenue from Myers Street to Pacific Street, from 8:00 a.m. to midnight, for the KSON CountryFest North Concert on May 13, 2006, and the Smooth Jazz 98.1 Jazz on the Beach Concerts on June 25, 2006, August 13, 2006, and October 8, 2006, at the Pier Amphitheater.

BACKGROUND

Jefferson Pilot Communications will be producing the KSON CountryFest North Concert on May 13, 2006, and the Smooth Jazz 98.1 Jazz on the Beach Concerts on June 25, 2006, August 13, 2006, and October 8, 2006, at the Pier Amphitheater. Jefferson Pilot Communications produced three successful sold-out concerts last year.

ANALYSIS

Consistent with City Council direction from the May 15, 2004, Special Events Workshop, all major street closure requests require City Council approval. Jefferson

Pilot Communications is requesting the temporary street closure of Pacific Street from Seagaze Drive to Pier View Way and Mission Avenue from Myers Street to Pacific Street, from 8:00 a.m. to midnight on May 13, 2006, June 25, 2006, August 13, 2006, and October 8, 2006. Jefferson Pilot Communications will provide advance notification to all businesses and residents advising of the street closures. Upon approval of the requested temporary street closures, Jefferson Pilot Communications will be required to employ a licensed traffic control company to provide a traffic control plan to be approved by the Public Works Director. All traffic control equipment and staffing necessary to facilitate the temporary street closure will be provided by a licensed traffic control company. Jefferson Pilot Communications will provide private security and event volunteers to monitor the events.

FISCAL IMPACT

No fiscal impact has been identified for this event. Jefferson Pilot Communications will pay all facility fees and City services.

INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

The City's standard insurance requirements will be met.

COMMITTEE OR COMMISSION REPORT

While the Special Events Committee does not have discretionary authority to close major arterial roadways, the Committee has reviewed this event application and will be working closely with the event organizer on additional logistics.

CITY ATTORNEY'S ANALYSIS

The California Vehicle Code authorizes the temporary closure of a public street for local special events, when, in the opinion of the local authorities, the closing is necessary for the safety and protection of the public who will be using the portion of street during the temporary closing.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that City Council approve Jefferson Pilot Communications' request for the temporary street closure of Pacific Street from Seagaze Drive to Pier View Way and Mission Avenue from Myers Street to Pacific Street, from 8:00 a.m. to midnight, for the KSON CountryFest North Concert on May 13, 2006, and the Smooth Jazz 98.1 Jazz on the Beach Concerts on June 25, 2006, August 13, 2006, and October 8, 2006, at the Pier Amphitheater.
