SUBJECT: **PURCHASE OF TWO PAY MACHINES FOR CITY PARKING LOTS**

SYNOPSIS

Staff recommends that the City Council approve a purchase order in an amount not to exceed \$35,579.05 with Pacific Parking Systems, Inc., of Irvine for the purchase of two pay machines for parking lots and authorize the Financial Services Director, or designee, to execute the purchase order.

BACKGROUND

The Public Works Department maintains 17 pay machines in parking lots. Fifteen of the older pay machines have been previously replaced. The remaining 2 pay machines are approximately 20 years old and have deteriorated to the point of becoming a maintenance burden.

ANALYSIS

Purchase of the new machines for Lot #22 and #27 will complete the replacement of pay machines in all lots to newer models. The new machines will not accept credit cards but 12 of the 17 machines currently do as these are located in the higher use areas.

For ease of maintenance and operation the new machines are the same type and model as the other 15 pay machines. The pay machines are a proprietary product of Pacific Parking which is the only licensed vendor in Southern California. The purchase complies with all applicable provisions of City Code Chapter 28A.

FISCAL IMPACT

The total cost of the new pay machines is \$35,579.05 and will be funded from the Public Works Parking Lot Maintenance and Enforcement Budget (Fund # 101.416110.5703).
