2 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
3 OCEANSIDE AMENDING SECTION 2.1.70 OF THE OCEANSIDE
4 CITY CODE TO ADJUST THE SALARY FOR MEMBERS OF THE
5 CITY COUNCIL IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF
6 SECTIONS 36516 AND 36516.5 OF THE CALIFORNIA
7 GOVERNMENT CODE

8 WHEREAS, Oceanside City Code section 2.1.70 establishes the salary of the
9 members of the City Council; and

10 WHEREAS, in 2002, City Council adopted Ordinance No. 02-OR501-1 reestablishing
11 the salary of the members of the City Council at the current amount of \$1,467.86 per month;
12 and

13 WHEREAS, Oceanside City Ordinance No. 85-26 established additional compensation
14 for the Mayor of \$150.00 per month; and

15 WHEREAS, Government Code section 36516 establishes a formula for making
16 adjustments to the salary paid to members of a city council; and

17 WHEREAS, the City Council desires to adjust the salary paid to members of the
18 Oceanside City Council as authorized by the Government Code.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Oceanside does ordain as follows:

20 SECTION 1. Section 2.1.70 of the Oceanside City Code is amended by the
21 amendment of subsection (a) to read as follows:

22 “(a) *Salary.* From and after the commencement of the first regular pay period
23 following the date established pursuant to subsection (b) the members of the City Council
24 shall receive a salary of \$1,541.25 per month in accordance with the provisions of Section
25 36516 of the California Government Code.”

26 SECTION 2. The City Council may by ordinance adjust the salary of its members
27 pursuant to Government Code Section 36516 provided however that any adjustment to
28 increase the salary shall become payable only on and after the date upon which one or more
members of the council becomes eligible there for by virtue of beginning a new term of office
following the next succeeding general municipal election held in the city, and then all
members of the council shall be entitled to the adjustment.

1 SECTION 3. Within fifteen (15) days after its passage, the City Clerk shall cause this
2 ordinance to be published pursuant to the provisions of California Government Code section
3 36933.

4 SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be effective thirty (30) days after its adoption.


