SUBJECT: **AUTHORIZATION TO AWARD A CONTRACT FOR THE MAPLE DRIVE AT SUNBURST DRIVE STORM DRAIN PROJECT AND AUTHORIZATION FOR THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT UPON RECEIPT OF ALL SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS**

**SYNOPSIS**

Staff recommends that the City Council award a contract in the amount of \$59,155 to C.W. Doherty Concrete of Oceanside for the Maple Drive at Sunburst Drive Storm Drain project and authorize the City Manager to execute the agreement upon receipt of all supporting documents.

**BACKGROUND**

Maple Drive is damaged by continuous groundwater runoff. The runoff supports the growth of algae and damages concrete in the cross gutter at Sunburst Drive, thus creating a potentially hazardous condition. City Council approved the plans and specifications for the Maple Drive at Sunburst Drive Storm Drain on March 8, 2006, and authorized the Public Works Director to call for bids.

**ANALYSIS**

The project was publicly advertised and contract documents were made available to Oceanside contractors. Requests for bids were issued on March 8, 2006. The lowest qualified bidder is C.W. Doherty Concrete from Oceanside. Staff reviewed the bid and determined that it is reasonable and fair. The following 12 sealed bids were opened on April 20, 2006.
