SUBJECT: PLACEMENT OF A PEARL HARBOR SURVIVORS MONUMENT

SYNOPSIS

Staff recommends that the Harbor Board of Directors authorize the placement of a Pearl Harbor Survivors Monument in Oceanside Harbor.

BACKGROUND

On July 6, 2005, the Harbor Board of Directors directed staff to work with the Pearl Harbor Survivors Association Chapter 31 in response to their request to have a monument placed adjacent to the Harbor Fishing Pier. The Pearl Harbor Survivors Association Chapter 31 has requested that the Harbor Board of Directors approve the placement.

ANALYSIS

The Harbor Fishing Pier is a key component of the Harbor and the community. It is located south of the Harbor office, in the 1400 block of Harbor Drive North. The Pearl Harbor Survivors Association Chapter 31 holds a memorial service there every December 7.

FISCAL IMPACT

No anticipated fiscal impact.

COMMISSION OR COMMITTEE REPORT

Staff brought this item to the Harbor and Beaches Advisory Committee at its March 23, 2006 meeting, for review and consideration. The Committee took action to recommend that the Harbor Board of Directors authorize placement of the monument.


CITY ATTORNEY'S ANALYSIS




