SUBJECT: **RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION TO THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA FOR GRANT FUNDS TO SUPPORT RECYCLING OF USED OIL AND PROPER DISPOSAL OF HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE**

SYNOPSIS

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt a resolution authorizing application to the State of California Integrated Waste Management Board for grant funds to support recycling of used oil and proper disposal of household hazardous waste, effective July 1, 2008, to June 30, 2013, and authorizing the City Manager, or designee, to execute grant-related documents.

BACKGROUND

The California Integrated Waste Management Board manages programs to encourage recycling and to reduce the amount of waste placed in State landfills. The State Legislature has enacted a number of programs to encourage recycling, to divert waste materials from landfills, and to provide for proper disposal of hazardous waste, including household hazardous wastes such as paint and aerosol containers. The Legislature has delegated management of these programs to the California Integrated Waste Management Board and has authorized the Board to provide grants to cities and counties for the collection and recycling of used oil and the collection and proper disposal of household hazardous wastes.

The City of Oceanside has applied for and received both direct allocations and competitive grant awards through these programs. The City currently works with Waste Management of North County to provide used oil and household hazardous waste collection programs for Oceanside residents. The grants have also provided funds for community education programs on recycling, proper disposal of wastes, and pollution prevention.

ANALYSIS

The City is an eligible applicant for grant funds from the California Integrated Waste Management Board, and has programs in place to collect used oil and household hazardous waste from residents. The Board requires a resolution from the governing body of an applicant jurisdiction authorizing application for such grant funds, and allows

a single resolution to cover all such grant applications for a five-year period. The City Council adopted Resolution 02-R766-1 on December 11, 2002, authorizing application for such grants until December 31, 2007. The resolution authorizes application for grant funds, but the City Council retains authority to accept or to reject individual grants when individual grants are presented to the Council for approval.

FISCAL IMPACT

The resolution authorizes application for grant funds to support local programs to collect and recycle used oil, and to collect and dispose of household hazardous wastes. The programs provide services to residents of the City without impact on the General Fund. Any grants requiring matching funds will be presented to the Council for approval.

CITY ATTORNEY'S ANALYSIS

The referenced documents have been reviewed by the City Attorney and reviewed as to form.

COMMITTEE OR COMMISSION REPORT

The Integrated Waste Commission has consistently reviewed the City's used oil collection and recycling program, and the household hazardous waste collection and disposal program, and recommended that the City apply for all appropriate grant funds to support such programs.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt a resolution authorizing application to the State of California Integrated Waste Management Board for grant funds to support recycling of used oil and proper disposal of household hazardous waste, effective July 1, 2008, to June 30, 2013, and authorizing the City Manager, or designee, to execute grant-related documents.

2 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
3 OCEANSIDE AUTHORIZING APPLICATION TO THE STATE
4 OF CALIFORNIA FOR GRANTS TO SUPPORT RECYCLING
5 OF USED OIL AND PROPER DISPOSAL OF HOUSEHOLD
6 HAZARDOUS WASTE

7 WHEREAS, the people of the State of California have enacted the California Oil
8 Recycling Enhancement Act that provides funds to cities and counties for establishing and
9 maintaining local used oil collection programs to encourage the recycling or appropriate
10 disposal of used oil;

11 WHEREAS, the people of the State of California have enacted Assembly Bill 1220 that
12 provides grants to local governments to establish and implement waste diversion and separation
13 programs to prevent disposal of hazardous waste, including household hazardous waste, in
14 solid waste landfills;

15 WHEREAS, the California Integrated Waste Management Board has been delegated the
16 responsibility for the administration of these programs within the State, setting up necessary
17 procedures governing application by cities and counties under these programs;

18 WHEREAS, the procedures established by the California Integrated Waste Management
19 Board require that the governing body of an applicant city or county authorize by resolution the
20 submittal of grant applications for all available grants under the California Oil Recycling
21 Enhancement Act and all available household hazardous waste grants under the California
22 Integrated Waste Management Act; and

23 WHEREAS, the City will enter into an agreement with the State of California for
24 development of any project funded with grants from the Integrated Waste Management Board.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Oceanside does resolve as follows:

26 SECTION 1. The submittal of grant applications to the California Integrated Waste
27 Management Board for all available grants under the California Oil Recycling Enhancement
28 Act and all available household hazardous waste grants under the California Integrated Waste
Management Act for the period of July 1, 2008, through June 30, 2013, is authorized.

1 SECTION 2. The City Manager, or the Director of the Public Works Department as
2 his/her designee, is hereby authorized and empowered to execute in the name of the City of
3 Oceanside all necessary applications, contracts, payment requests, agreements and amendments
4 hereto for the purposes of securing grant funds and to implement and carry out the purposes
5 specified in the grant application.
