SUBJECT: **ADOPTION OF A RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT \$46,981 IN GRANT FUNDS FROM THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF CONSERVATION TO BE USED IN RECYCLING, EDUCATION AND LITTER REDUCTION ACTIVITIES**

SYNOPSIS

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt a resolution authorizing acceptance of \$46,981 in grant funds, awarded to the City of Oceanside, and approve the budgeting of these funds to the Public Works Department's Beverage Container Grant Program.

BACKGROUND

The City of Oceanside is eligible to apply for State grants from the California Department of Conservation pursuant to Section 14581(a) of the California Beverage Container Recycling and Litter Reduction Act (the Act). The funds are to be used in programs related to beverage container recycling, litter collection and educational projects. The funds are distributed on a per capita basis.

ANALYSIS

The adoption of the Act by the State Legislature in 1999 enabled cities to apply for funds to be used in such programs. Funds may be used only for specific purposes to encourage recycling of beverage containers, enhance recycling programs, provide educational information and expand public awareness regarding the need to recycle and reduce litter. Adoption of a resolution by the City Council is required to accept the funds to be used to support and implement new and ongoing programs.

FISCAL IMPACT

The funds awarded in FY 2006-07 in the amount of \$46,981 are limited to specific beverage container recycling, education and anti-litter programs. These programs will assist the City to achieve the waste tonnage diversion which is required and implement programs mandated by AB939, the 1989 State of California Integrated Waste

Management Act. A budget appropriation is necessary in the amount of \$46,981 in grant funds from the California Department of Conservation to the Beverage Container Grant account (272.416171.4456.00026) for reimbursement of \$18,322 in special departmental supplies (272.416171.5223), \$16,443 in miscellaneous materials and supplies (272.416171.5229), \$941 in travel/training fees (272.416171.5292) and \$11,275 in personnel costs (272.416171.5101).

COMMISSION OR COMMITTEE REPORT

At its August 22, 2006 meeting, the Integrated Waste Commission reviewed and approved the current programs for the grant funds.

CITY ATTORNEY'S ANALYSIS

The referenced documents have been reviewed by the City Attorney and approved as to form.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt a resolution authorizing acceptance of \$46,981 in grant funds, awarded to the City of Oceanside, and approve the budgeting of these funds to the Public Works Department's Beverage Container Grant Program.


