

**FILING OF CAMPAIGN FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE STATEMENTS FOR**  
**November 6<sup>th</sup>, 2012**

In compliance with the Political Reform Act, Sections 84200.7(b) and 84204, all candidates/committees must file Campaign Statements at various stages of the election process. For your information, these regular deadlines are as follows:

October 5, 2012	July 1 – September 30, 2012
October 25, 2012	October 1 – October 20, 2012
January 31, 2013	October 21 – December 31, 2012

 BY THE DEADLINE DATES LISTED -  
 SEE BELOW FOR THE 24-HOUR FILING REQUIREMENT**

Late filings of campaign statements are subject to penalties and fines, which accrue at the rate of \$10.00 per day, starting the day after the filing deadline until the statement or report is filed with the City Clerk. The maximum penalty is \$100 or the total amount of contributions received or expenditures made (whichever is greater) during the period covered by the late statement.

It is important that you read all information on campaign disclosure carefully and comply with the instructions for proper reporting and timely filing of your campaign statements. <sup>1</sup>The period covered by any statement begins on the day after the closing date of the last statement filed, or January 1 if no previous statement has been filed.

<sup>2</sup> The recipient of a late in-kind contribution must file a Late Contribution Report within 48 hours from the time the in-kind contribution is received.

<sup>3</sup> A controlled committee of a candidate may not make an independent expenditure to support or oppose another candidate (Gov. Code § 85501).
