

Oceanside Youth Scholarship Program

FAQs:

How can I apply for a scholarship?

- (2) Print out the application and mail to:

- (3) Come in person to the Parks and Recreation office
All applications and scholarship enrollments are processed at the Parks and Recreation Administration office ONLY!

What do I need to provide?

- (1) Proof of residency
- (2) Birth Certificate(s), if available
- (3) If your child receives the free/reduced lunch program at an Oceanside or Vista Unified School you will need to provide a copy of the qualification letter from the school.
- (4) If your child is not participating in the free/reduced lunch program at school, then you will need to supply the last two current pay stubs to prove your monthly income and/or the current tax year filed.

If I am on Section 8 do I automatically qualify?

No.

Do I have to be an Oceanside resident?

Yes, only Oceanside residents are eligible for the Youth Scholarship Program.

Can I receive a 100% scholarship?

There is **NO** 100% qualification. A family will be responsible for paying 50% of each program a child enrolls in.

How much money can I receive?

A qualifying family can use up to \$150 per year, per family, regardless of the number of children. *(while funds are available)*

When are applications accepted?

Applications are accepted year-round or until funds run out, whichever occurs first.

What is the most I could receive annually?

The top fixed dollar amount is \$150 per family. *(while funds are available)*

Can I roll it over? What if I don't use it?

Applicants who do not use all the scholarship monies will not be able to carry them over but they can reapply when your scholarship expires.
