SUBJECT: **PARTICIPATION IN A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE CITY OF OCEANSIDE AND NORTH COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT**

SYNOPSIS

Staff recommends that the City Council approve a three-year memorandum of understanding with North County Fire Protection District in a first-year amount of \$82,000 and increases to the second and third year as governed by the San Diego Consumer Price Index (CPI) rate, for technical services provided by the Information Technologies Department; and authorize the City Manager to execute the agreement.

BACKGROUND

Information Technologies (I.T.) staff have been providing network, hardware, software support, as well as maintenance of the copiers/printers owned by North County Fire Protection District (NCFPD) since July 2010, through a previously-approved Memorandum of Understanding. At that time, NCFPD approached the City as they desired to create an interagency partnership allowing them to forego direct hires and to acquire the expertise of a fully vetted I.T. unit.

In 2012, the range of support began to increase at the request of North County Fire Protection District (NCFPD) to include the monitoring of twelve servers, server back-ups, network uninterrupted power supplies (UPS), telephone/fax systems, microwave system and a marquee sign.

The majority of the technical support functions required to maintain NCFPD's network are facilitated by remote connection to NCFPD's network, while I.T. staff are physically located on City property. With the remote access and leveraging additional technologies, existing I.T. staff has maintained the required level of support for City services along with providing the necessary level of support for NCFPD.

ANALYSIS

The City recognizes additional revenue while providing technical support for NCFPD with a cost effective level of reliable network security for their servers, UPS, hardware, software applications, desktop workstations, notebooks, as well as support of copiers/printers and the microwave system.

FISCAL IMPACT

The MOU requires a first-year technical services payment of \$82,000, payable in equal monthly installments for services provided by the Information Technologies Division. The technical services payment will increase the second and third year by the San Diego Consumer Price Index (CPI) rate. The service payments under the MOU will be deposited in the Information Technologies revenue account number 155164841.4501.




RECOMMENDATION



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MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between the

CITY OF OCEANSIDE

And

NORTH COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT

1.0. GENERAL:

- 1.1. It is the intent and purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Oceanside and North County Fire Protection District collectively "the parties" to set forth the understanding reached by the parties regarding matters of the professional technical on-site support provided by the City of Oceanside Information Technologies Division.
- 1.2. The goal of the project is to utilize existing Information Technologies staff member resources from the City of Oceanside to fulfill a need at the North County Fire Protection District, in exchange;
- 1.3. North County Fire Protection District will reimburse the City of Oceanside for defined hardware and network support including servers, switches, network UPS's, desktop and notebooks, copiers/printers, software application support, microwave system support and trouble-shooting support. Refer to the attached **Exhibit A** and **Exhibit B** for a complete list of the support services. The use of the City's technical support staff will provide North County Fire Protection District with the security of reliable desktop workstations, notebooks, copiers/printers, microwave system, software application support and network technical support. This project provides a win-win solution for both North County Fire Protection District and the City of Oceanside.

2.0. PARTIES MUTUALLY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

2.1. SCOPE OF PROJECT:

- 2.1.1. The Memorandum of Understanding governs a three (3) year commitment relating to the following technical services:
 - 2.1.1.1. Proactive monitoring of twelve (12) servers.
 - 2.1.1.2. Provide technical remote connection and on-site support of equipment owned by North County Fire Protection District including: software applications, desktops, notebooks, copiers/printers, telephone/fax systems and marquee sign;
 - 2.1.1.3. Provide technical remote connection and on-site administrative support of network hardware/software, network UPS's, Website host and FTP access to Website for editing, MDC/MCT support, and server backups;
 - 2.1.1.4. Provide network, server backup, desktop workstation/notebook, and MDC/MCT trouble shooting;
 - 2.1.1.5. Normal workday remote connection and on-site support will be provided from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM, Monday through Friday. The remote connection approach will be utilized first to resolve support requests.

- 2.1.1.6. Specialized support, emergency trouble shooting and/or emergency response will be provided on a time and materials basis, outside of the standard 8 AM to 5 PM window.
- 2.1.1.7. Coordinate vendor support for the microwave system. Provide trouble shooting assistance, as well as monitor and manage the existing microwave system.
- 2.1.1.8. Provide labor only support once a month for cleaning, and as needed installation of parts purchased by North County Fire, to maintain the existing Xerox printer fleet owned by North County Fire. The City will also troubleshoot Xerox machine issues during regular business hours. North County Fire will be responsible for the purchase of all consumables and repair/maintenance parts. If it is mutually determined it is not cost effective to repair a specific machine after troubleshooting the repair issue, North County Fire will purchase a comparable new Dell printer. The City will install the new printer and configure the print drivers.
- 2.1.1.9. Refer to the attached **Exhibit A** and **Exhibit B** for a complete list of the supported services including hardware, software, copiers/printers, telephone/fax support as well as MDC/MCT, Marquee Sign and Server Back-up support.
- 2.2. Support does not include software support for programming projects or software outside of the software outlined in **Exhibit B**, proprietary software, customized applications, web-based applications, macro creation or end user training.
- 2.3. All technical support shall be solely provided by the City of Oceanside Information Technologies Division to North County Fire Protection District, as set forth in the text of this document. Each year on the anniversary date of the executed Memorandum of Understanding the annual compensation for services will increase based on the San Diego Urban CIP. This Memorandum of Understanding constitutes the entire agreement between the City of Oceanside and North County Fire Protection District with respect to the deliverables. This Memorandum of Understanding supersedes all prior oral and written communications. This Memorandum of Understanding may be amended, modified or changed, only in writing when signed by all parties or their specifically authorized representatives.
- 2.4. North County Fire Protection District shall comply with all applicable federal, state and local laws, standards, codes, ordinances, administrative regulations and all amendments and additions thereto, pertaining in any manner to the performance or services provided under this Memorandum of Understanding. The City of Oceanside shall obtain all patents, licenses and any other permission required to provide the services or deliverables to North County Fire Protection District, or shall provide, upon the approval by North County Fire Protection District, alternate, equivalent services, work products or deliverables for use by North County Fire Protection District, provided the City of Oceanside shall not unreasonably withhold approval of reasonable alternatives which do not significantly increase the cost or burden upon the North County Fire Protection District or the North County Fire Protection District's equipment, systems, staff or facilities. North County Fire Protection District has no obligation for any claim based upon a modified version of

the Software or the combination or operation of the software and hardware with any product, data or apparatus not provided by the City of Oceanside. The City of Oceanside provides no warranty whatsoever for any third-party hardware or software products. Except as expressly set forth herein, the City of Oceanside disclaims any and all express and implied warranties, including but not necessarily limited to warranties of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose.

3.0. **COMPENSATION:**

3.1. For the City of Oceanside's performance of services, including technical labor cost, materials (necessary replacement of servers, hard drives, etc., software licensing (refer to **Exhibit B**) North County Fire Protection District shall pay the City of Oceanside the compensation as follows as part of the three (3) year Memorandum of Understanding – Year One:

3.1.1. \$6,833.34 per month. Total first year project cost \$82,000.

3.1.2. All requests for specialized system enhancements, troubleshooting, etc. will be charged at an hourly rate of \$75 per hour (salary plus overhead).

3.1.3. Beginning the second year, the cost of support and maintenance will be increased by the San Diego Consumer Price Index (CPI) rate in effect on the anniversary date of the agreement.

3.2. North County Fire Protection District and the City of Oceanside acknowledge that the compensation to be paid to the City of Oceanside pursuant to this Memorandum of Understanding has been established at minimum for the services performed by the City of Oceanside as described herein. No rate changes shall be made during the term of this Memorandum of Understanding without prior written approval of the Chief Information Officer. The City of Oceanside will not incur non-reimbursable expenses.

4.0. **SYSTEM SUPPORT:**

4.1. The following terms and conditions will govern the maintenance of the system support provided by the City of Oceanside to North County Fire Protection District:

4.1.1. **SUPPORT SERVICES:** North County Fire Protection District may contact Technical Support by dialing (760) 435-4500. The City of Oceanside's Customer Care Center, which is available Monday through Friday from 8 AM to 5 PM, excluding the City of Oceanside's observed holidays will contact the technical support staff member. For after hour and observed holiday emergency support the phone number is (760) 435-3800. North County Fire Protection District representatives must allow a two (2) hour technical support response time for all support requests.

4.1.2. **REMOTE SUPPORT:** When required to properly resolve a troubleshooting support request, for the network, Website (www.ncfire.org), MDC/MCT, a desktop or notebook, the City of Oceanside will provide remote assistance

to North County Fire Protection District via a mutually acceptable remote communication method.

4.1.3. **ON-SITE SUPPORT:** The City of Oceanside will provide on-site technical support as needed at all six (6) fire station locations and the administration building.

4.1.4. **TERM OF ON-SITE SUPPORT SERVICES:** The first annual term of services will commence upon execution of this Memorandum of Understanding. The Memorandum of Understanding will automatically renew annually for a total period of three (3) calendar years beginning from the date of the execution of this Memorandum of Understanding. North County Fire Protection District may terminate the on-site technical support services by providing a written notice ninety (90) days prior to the annual renewal date.

5.0. **TERMINATION OF MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING:**

5.1. Either party may terminate this Memorandum of Understanding if the other party materially breaches this Memorandum of Understanding, and after receiving a written notice describing the circumstances of the default, fails to correct the breach within thirty (30) calendar days. In addition, either party may terminate this Agreement for convenience by providing ninety (90) days written notice to the other party. Upon any termination of Memorandum of Understanding, all rights granted to North County Fire Protection District by the City of Oceanside are cancelled and revert to the City of Oceanside, except as otherwise provided in this Memorandum of Understanding.

5.2. Upon receipt of the notice of termination from North County Fire Protection District, the City of Oceanside shall immediately discontinue all services affected (unless the notice directs otherwise). Upon termination by North County Fire Protection District, North County Fire Protection District shall pay the City of Oceanside for reasonable work and services rendered, up to the time of the notice of termination, in accordance with the terms, limits and conditions of the Memorandum of Understanding.

6.0. **INDEMNIFICATION:**

6.1. North County Fire Protection District shall indemnify and hold harmless the City of Oceanside and its officers, agents and employees against all claims for damages to persons or property arising out of the conduct, negligent acts, errors or omissions or wrongful acts of conduct of North County Fire Protection District, or its employees, agents, subcontractors, or others in connection with the execution of the work covered by this Agreement, except for those claims arising from the willful misconduct, sole negligence or active negligence of the City of Oceanside, its officers, agents, or employees. North County Fire Protection District indemnification shall include any and all costs, expenses, attorneys' fees, expert fees and liability assessed against or incurred by the City of Oceanside, its officers, agents, or employees in defending against such claims or lawsuits, whether the same proceed to judgment or not. Further, North County Fire Protection District at its own expense shall, upon written request by the City of Oceanside, defend any

such suit or action brought against the City of Oceanside, its officers, agents, or employees resulting or arising from the conduct, tortious acts or omissions of North County Fire Protection District. Except for the provisions of the Indemnity, which shall survive the termination of the Memorandum of Understanding, in the event this Memorandum of Understanding is terminated hereunder, North County Fire Protection District shall pay the City of Oceanside's properly documented invoices, if any, in accordance with the provisions of this Memorandum of Understanding, through the date of termination and the period set forth in the notice, and thereafter North County Fire Protection District shall have no further liability under this Memorandum of Understanding to the City of Oceanside and the City of Oceanside shall have no further obligations to North County Fire Protection District.

- 6.2. The City of Oceanside shall indemnify and hold harmless the North County Fire Protection District and its officers, agents and employees against all claims for damages to persons or property arising out of the conduct, negligent acts, errors or omissions or wrongful acts of conduct of the City of Oceanside, or its employees, agents, subcontractors, or others in connection with the execution of the work covered by this Agreement, except for those claims arising from the willful misconduct, sole negligence or active negligence of the North County Fire Protection District, its officers, agents, or employees. The City of Oceanside's indemnification shall include any and all costs, expenses, attorneys' fees, expert fees and liability assessed against or incurred by the North County Fire Protection District, its officers, agents, or employees in defending against such claims or lawsuits, whether the same proceed to judgment or not. Further, the City of Oceanside, at its own expense shall, upon written request by the North County Fire Protection District, defend any such suit or action brought against the North County Fire Protection District, its officers, agents, or employees resulting or arising from the conduct, tortious acts or omissions of the City of Oceanside. The provisions of the Indemnity, shall survive the termination of the Memorandum of Understanding, in the event this Memorandum of Understanding is terminated hereunder.

7.0. **NO ASSIGNMENT WITHOUT CONSENT:**

- 7.1. This Memorandum of Understanding and any portion thereof shall not be assigned or transferred, nor shall any of the City Of Oceanside's duties be delegated, without the express written consent of the City. Any attempt to assign or delegate this Memorandum of Understanding without the express written consent of the City shall be void and of no force or effect. Consent by the City of Oceanside to one assignment shall not be deemed consent to any subsequent assignment. This Memorandum of Understanding shall inure to the benefit of and be binding upon the parties hereto and their respective successors and assigns. The Chief Information Officer is hereby authorized to approve a change on behalf of the City of Oceanside.

8.0. **EFFECTIVE DATE:**

- 8.1. This Memorandum of Understanding shall become effective **July 1, 2013**.


9.0. **SIGNATURES:**




