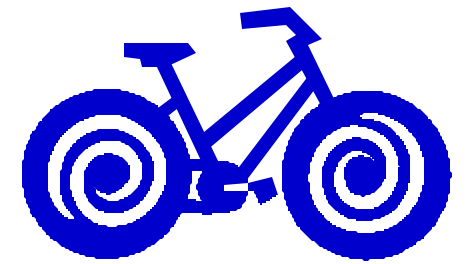

Getting Started How do I get a Blue Bike™?



The Dasani® Blue Bikes™ Program is designed to be very easy for the public to use! The 20 TREK® Cruiser bikes are available to participants 13 and older 7 days a week including holidays. Participants must simply follow these steps to get started:

- **Visit the Parks and Recreation Division at 300 North Coast Highway to register.** You will be asked to show a photo ID and will need to fill out some paperwork, including an information sheet and participant waiver.
- Once you are registered you will receive a Blue Bikes™ “smart card”. This card gives you access to the Dasani® Bike Lockers located at 602 Civic Center Drive. Bike access is available seven days a week from sun-up to sun-down.

Why Oceanside? Where did the City get the Money for 20 TREK® Cruiser Bikes?

The Dasani® Blue Bikes™ were donated to the City by Dasani®, TREK®, and the Rails to Trails Conservancy. The program costs the City nothing to operate. Dasani® provides the equipment and covers the cost of regular maintenance for the life of the bikes and the program.

The San Luis Rey River Trail– Oceanside is so incredibly lucky to have a 7.2 mile Class I Bike Trail. The trail provides space for recreational activities such as walking, running and cycling and also gives the premier athlete a safe and beautiful space to train. The trail is used each day by hundreds of recreational and nature enthusiasts who want to enjoy the outdoors while getting their exercise.

The Dasani® Blue Bikes™ Program - Dasani®, TREK® Bikes and The Rails to Trails Conservancy has teamed up to bring new bikes to many cities across America in an effort to expand the use of trail systems. The idea is that providing bikes free-of-charge to the community will help families access recreation and create healthier lifestyles for all. Oceanside was chosen as one of the recipient cities because of the beautiful San Luis Rey River Trail and the Coastal Rail Trail. Oceanside is the first city in California to receive this program. **Way to go Oceanside!!!**

Using the Blue Bikes™

The Dasani® Blue Bikes™ are very high quality TREK® Cruiser Bikes. They need special care to ensure they last and that many riders can safely enjoy them for years to come. Please follow the following steps when using a Blue Bike™:



Inspect the Bike– Look for damage, flattened tires or other visible signs that the bike needs some TLC. If you find a bike in need of repair please notify Parks and Recreation staff by calling (760) 435-5041. During non-business hours please leave a message and return the bike to the locker and choose another bike.



Remember, Safety First - When you are riding the Blue Bikes™ please observe all the “rules of the road” and be aware of traffic and other distractions. Be a safe and cautious rider, especially when riding with children!

You may only take one bike at a time. If you have multiple riders, each rider must register for a card. Riders must be 13 years or older. Riders under 18 must be accompanied by an adult.
