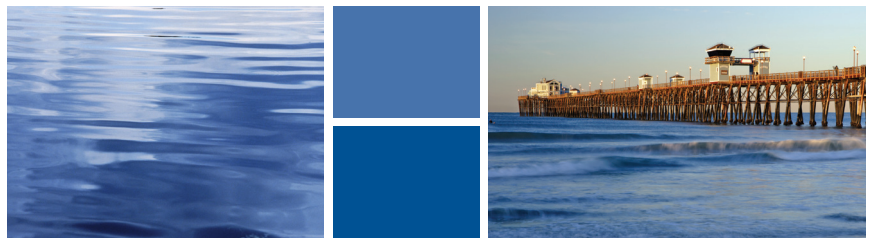


San Luis Rey River

Beach Sites

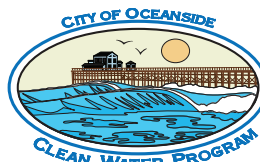
These sites tend to fill up so please consider the San Luis Rey River sites.
