1915-2015

Exhibition Reception—April 25—6-8 p.m.

This exhibition will feature works by one hundred distinguished artists who lived and worked in San Diego during the last century and who were, or are currently, Guild members.

They range from historically significant Plein Air painters such as Maurice Braun, Charles Fries, Alfred Mitchell, and Charles Reiffel, to contemporary masters such as John Baldessari and Richard Allen Morris.

Established in 1915, the Guild was instrumental in founding The San Diego Museum of Art in 1926 and, to this day remains an integral part of San Diego's visual arts scene.

The exhibition will run through July 26, 2015.
