

Beach Area Improvements



Have you noticed improvements to the beach area lately? In addition to the new restrooms being constructed, maintenance staff has been making several other improvements. Beach access stairwells, handrails and decks were replaced at Tyson Park (*left*), Ash Street and 1919 South Pacific and staff is in the process of replacing the beach access at Civic Center Drive (North of Beach Community Center). Beach access points at Neptune, Windward, and Cassidy will be replaced by the end of 2015.

Strand Beach Park (*right*) just south of Seagaze was recently renovated with all new irrigation, landscaping, and picnic tables. The irrigation system and some sod at Tyson Park were replaced and new plants will be installed in the near future.



The amphitheater area (*left*) is in the process of receiving new landscaping and will be getting new LED spotlights next month. New LED lights will also be installed in all of the parking lots along the beach this summer.

A pier brace replacement project will begin in early summer without disrupting any activities or pedestrian access. Several water fountains were added and all existing fountains were replaced along the beach. Concrete stairs and handrails were replaced in multiple locations and a bollard replacement project will also start in the near future.
