


## Art After Dark October 30



A comedic farce written by the Michael Frayn, this is a concept of a play within a play, in this case a dreadful farce called "Nothing On" — the type of production in which many doors continually open and shut.

The setting is Des Moines, Iowa, where a second-rate theatrical troupe is preparing to perform the Broadway-bound play. Complicating matters are the personal problems and backstage relationships that have fostered jealousy and petty squabbling and intruded upon any professionalism this motley crew can muster. As the company works its way to New York City, the eccentricities of the cast come to the forefront and the performances on the road dissolve into chaos on and off stage.
