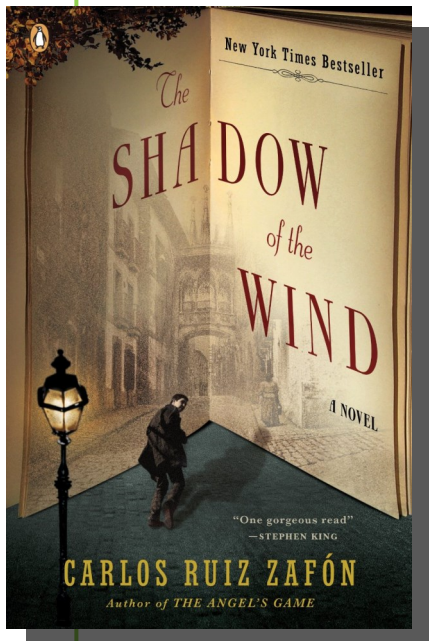


One Book One San Diego October 17
