Digital Literacy Tutor

Purpose: To assist novice computer users with digital devices and basic computer questions.

Responsibilities: Providing one-on-one assistance to Library patrons. Clearly explain basic computer operations and demonstrate a knowledge of new technologies such as eBooks and eReaders.

Time Commitment: Two hours per week.
