The City of Oceanside Clean Water Program is coordinating the Buena Vista Creek Cleanup in conjunction with California Coastal Cleanup day on Saturday, September 17, 2016 from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. This cleanup effort helps remove debris from Buena Vista Creek that can be transferred to Buena Vista Lagoon and the ocean.

Volunteers will receive a free give-away item, refreshments and community service hour documentation.

Participants can meet at any one of the five designated sites:

- Behind Fire Station #4 at Lake Boulevard and Thunder Dr.
- Behind Dick's Sporting Goods store on Plaza Drive
- Behind the Kohl's Shopping Center on Marron Road
- South side of the Oceanside Pier
- Buccaneer Park at Pacific St. and Morse St. (site hosted by Harrah's Rincon Casino)

Volunteers are asked to pre-register at www.CleanUpDay.org. Beach locations fill quickly. Please consider registering for Buena Vista Creek sites where debris removal is most needed.

We encourage you to reduce your carbon footprint by bringing your own bucket to collect trash, reusable gloves and reusable water bottle. Otherwise, supplies will be available.
