City Council Meetings are shown "live" on KOCT Channel 19 on two Wednesdays (1st & 3rd) of each month beginning at 5:00 p.m. and replayed on the following Thursday at 2:00 p.m., Saturday at 11:00 a.m., and Sunday at 5:00 p.m.
