- 27 4. These community outreach meetings will be held at the times and locations set forth  
28 in Attachment 3 of the staff report for this item. The City Manager is authorized to  
29 modify the timeline provided all legal requirements are met.

- 1 5. The City Council hereby calls special council meetings for July 25, 2017 for the  
2 purpose of reviewing and providing direction on the draft district boundaries and  
3 August 1, 2017 to consider introduction of an ordinance approving the district  
4 boundaries.
- 5 6. The City Council adopts the following criteria to guide the establishment of district  
6 for councilmember elections:
- 7 i. Each district should contain nearly the same number of people;
  - 8 ii. Boundaries shall be drawn in a manner that complies with the  
9 United States Constitution and the FVRA;
  - 10 iii. Council districts shall consist of contiguous territory in as compact  
11 form as practicable;
  - 12 iv. Districts shall follow visible features and boundaries when  
13 possible;
  - 14 v. Council districts shall respect communities of interest as much as  
15 practicable. Communities of interest generally refers to a contiguous population  
16 which shares common social and economic interests that should be included within a  
17 single district for purposes of fair and effective representation;
  - 18 vi. The demographer will disregard the location of incumbents and  
19 candidates as well as the interests of political parties.




