Eastside Community Cleanup Event

Oceanside's Housing & Neighborhood Services Department hosts quarterly neighborhood community clean-ups. City staff from Neighborhood Services Resource Centers and Code Enforcement work with community volunteer groups (such as Save Our Streets (SOS), Adopt-a-Block groups, faith-based groups or residents associations) to assist local residents in cleaning up the community.

Residents are encouraged to bring their old items to a central location and volunteers are available to unload and deposit in dumpsters. Volunteers range from 20-40 volunteers per event.

The Eastside community clean-up on May 13 had 35 volunteers from AKA Sorority, Grace Church, Vista Community Clinic REACH program, and the Eastside Neighborhood Association.

These committed volunteers filled four 40 cubic yard bins! Coffee, OJ, and donuts were provided in the morning and volunteers enjoyed a Chick-Fil-A lunch.
