## **OVERALL CRIME DOWN IN OCEANSIDE** **San Diego region mid-year 2017** **crime statistics published**

Since 1980, SANDAG has been reporting regional crime statistics for San Diego County. The study found that the City of Oceanside's **overall FBI Index Crime rate** per 1,000 population (including homicide, rape, robbery, aggravated assault, burglary, larceny, and motor vehicle theft) has decreased 8 percent since 2013, and decreased 1 percent over last year.

The City's **property crime** rate (burglary, larceny, and motor vehicle theft) dropped by 2 percent when compared to 2016. Another category, **violent crime**, increased slightly over last year, but shows an overall decreasing trend from 2013-2017 by 6 percent. The report also notes that Oceanside's population has risen by 2 percent to 175,948.

SANDAG obtains crime data from every regional agency on a monthly basis, allowing the presentation of regional crime data in a timely manner. Crime statistics for January through December 2017 are expected to be available in April 2018.
