

1 PROCLAMATION NO.

2 A PROCLAMATION OF THE EXISTENCE OF A LOCAL
3 EMERGENCY BY THE DIRECTOR OF EMERGENCY
4 SERVICES FOR THE CITY OF OCEANSIDE

5 WHEREAS, City of Oceanside Ordinance No. 73-22 empowers the Director of
6 Emergency Services to proclaim the existence or threatened existence of a local emergency
7 when the city is affected or likely to be affected by a public calamity and the City Council is
8 not in session; and

9 WHEREAS, on February 19, 2020 the San Diego County Board of Supervisors voted to
10 ratify the County's declaration of a local health emergency to address the novel coronavirus,
11 or COVID-19; and

12 WHEREAS, on March 4, 2020, the Governor proclaimed a statewide emergency
13 regarding the novel COVID-19 virus which is incorporated herein by reference and since that
14 time, conditions have continued to worsen; and

15 WHEREAS, the Director of Emergency Services finds that conditions and threatened
16 conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons have arisen with the City of Oceanside
17 caused by the expanding threat of the novel COVID-19 virus, the potential existence of positive
18 persons within the City and potential isolation and quarantine of residents, businesses,
19 employees and public safety workers;

20 WHEREAS, the Director of Emergency Services of the City of Oceanside does hereby
21 find:

22 1. Conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property have arisen within
23 the City caused by the novel COVID-19 virus and

24 2. The City Council of the City of Oceanside is not in session and cannot immediately
25 be called into session;

26 NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby proclaimed as follows:

27 SECTION 1. A local emergency now exists throughout the City of Oceanside; and

28 SECTION 2. During the existence of this local emergency, authorized employees of the

1 City of the Oceanside may exercise the powers, functions and duties as prescribed by state law,
2 by the ordinances and resolutions of the City of Oceanside and by the City of Oceanside
3 Emergency Plan.


4 SECTION 3. The Director of Emergency Services and/or her designee is hereby
5 designated as the authorized representatives of the City of Oceanside for the purpose of receipt,
6 processing and coordination of all inquiries and requirements to obtain available state and
7 federal assistance.


