**The Arena Califino**, a multi-purpose sports arena and events facility coming to El Corazon recently broke ground. The 171,291 sq. ft. arena will be built on 5 acres at the eastern end of the property near Rancho Del Oro Drive.

The indoor arena will seat 6,367 people for sporting events and 7,922 people for concerts. The arena will also feature a 36,000 sq. ft. outdoor plaza for events and receptions, on the southwest corner of the property, closest to the new aquatics center.
