Teens participating in Oceanside Public Library's Summer Reading Program will once again *Read for a Reason*. Each year, the teens pick a charitable organization in Oceanside to support, and for every book read, a donation of \$1 is made to that group. This summer's *Read for a Reason* recipient will be the North County Community Services Food Bank. Established in Oceanside in 1988, the food bank provides meals for hungry families across North County. Food barrels will also be set-up in the lobbies of both Oceanside Library locations for the donation of canned goods. In addition, the Library will be offering "Food for Fines" on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Friday of June, July and August. For every canned food item donated, \$1 in overdue fines will be waived, up to \$10. The Teen Summer Reading Program runs from June 13 to August 3, and is sponsored by the Friends of the Oceanside Public Library, with generous support from G.G. Greene Enterprises.
