Youth will gain experience through a one-month training and will be assigned a Police Advisor. What a great way to explore and learn about a rewarding career!

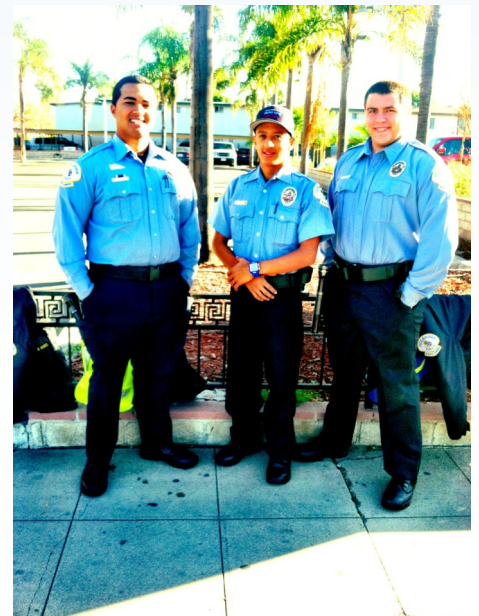
Explorer candidates must meet standards in order to qualify for participation in the program. During the application process, a complete records and background check is performed, and personal references are contacted.
