American Music Series

6 week series on Tuesday evenings at 6 p.m

Beginning October 8

America's Music is a 6-week series of programs about 20th century American popular music featuring documentary film screenings, scholar-led discussions, and live musical performances. The six sessions will focus on uniquely American musical genres: blues and gospel, Broadway, jazz, bluegrass and country, rock 'n' roll, and mambo and hip hop. The Oceanside Public Library is one of only 50 sites nationwide selected to host "America's Music: A Film History of Our Popular Music from Blues to Bluegrass to Broadway," a project of the Tribeca Film Institute in collaboration with the American Library Association, Tribeca Flashpoint and the Society for American Music. "America's Music" in Oceanside has been made possible by a grant from the National Endowment for the Humanities, matched by The Friends of the Oceanside Public Library and the Oceanside Public Library Foundation to add live performances and special guests. 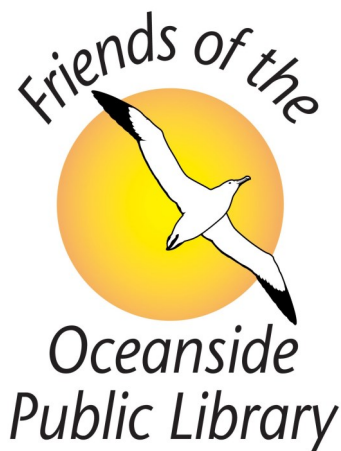


Paws to Read at the Library

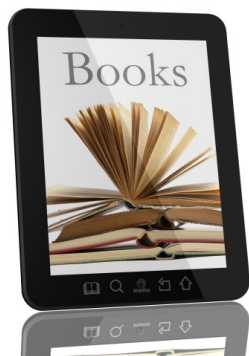

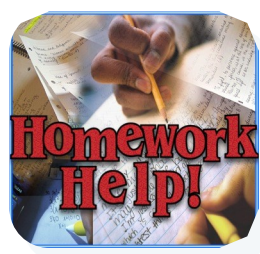


Learn to Download EBooks
