

# Mission Avenue IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

Open for Business During Construction



Saint Mary, Star of the Sea Parish, in partnership with Main Street Oceanside and the City of Oceanside has generously allowed use of their parking lot, located on the **southwest corner of Pier View and Freeman Street**. Business patrons may enjoy 2 hour parking.

## Project Description:

Mission Avenue, located between Horne Street and Coast Highway, is being renovated, and the project is due for completion in Summer 2014. Mission Avenue will be converted to a west bound one way route only. Seagaze Drive, one block south of Mission Avenue, will be converted to a one-way east bound route, creating a one-way couplet system in the Downtown area.

## Project components include:

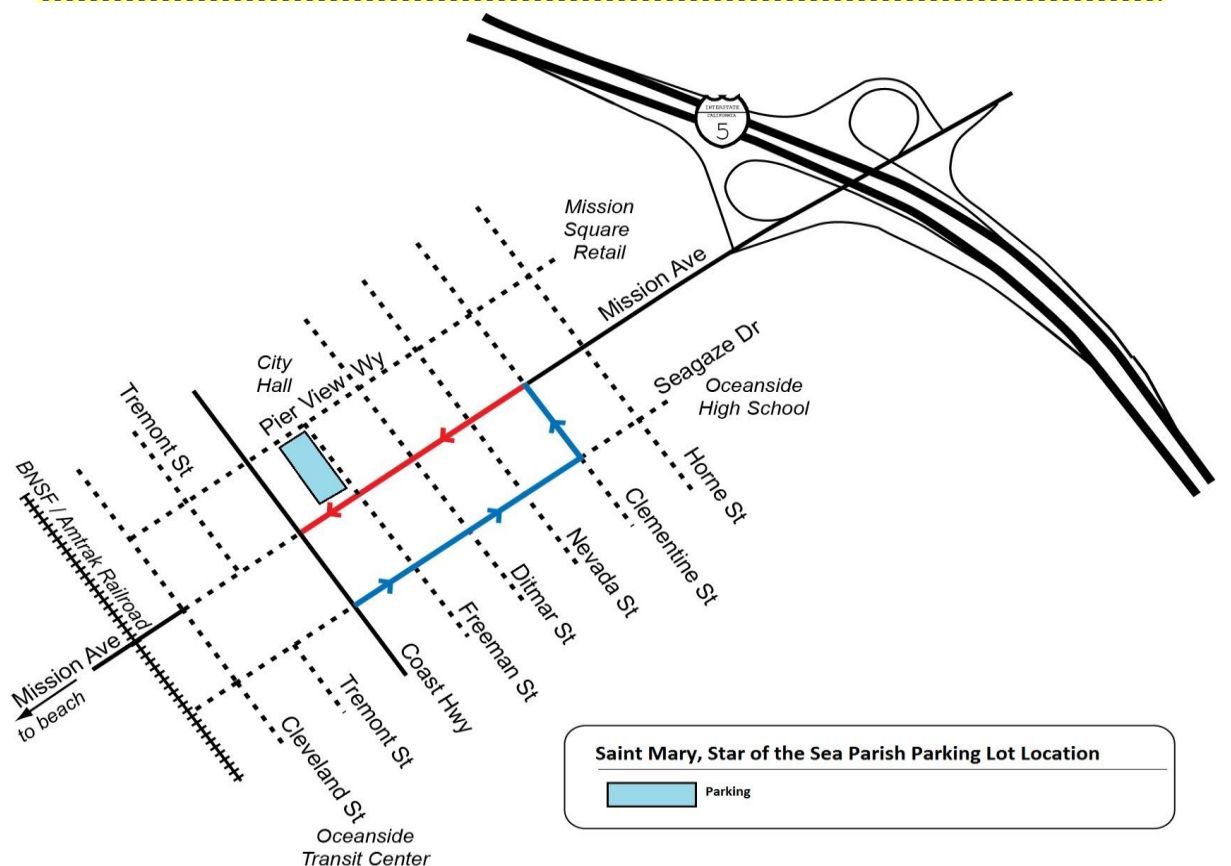
- New widened sidewalks 5' to 30' in width
- Intersection bulb outs for pedestrian crossing
- New landscaping
- New irrigation
- Street furniture
- Decorative Street Lights
- Shared travel lanes for bicycles and vehicles (along Mission, Seagaze, and Cleveland)
- Phased construction program, 2 blocks at a time, one side of the street. Access to all businesses will be maintained at all times.
- Programmed space for public art.

Work on the Improvement Project continues as planned. Demolition of sidewalk, curb, gutter and asphalt have been completed on the north side of Mission from Ditmar to Coast Highway. A portion of rough grading has been completed. On January 20, work began relocating a water main on Mission Ave. Work will resume east of Ditmar during this period preparing infiltration basins and planter areas. After the water main is in place, conduit for street lights and traffic signals will be installed west of Ditmar to Coast Highway. Then grading and forming work for curb, gutter and sidewalk placement west of Ditmar will take place.
