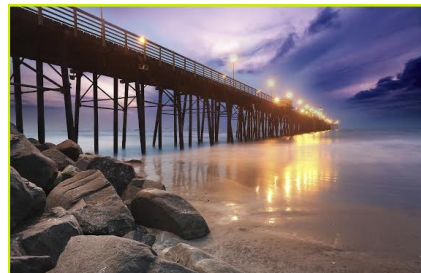

Molenkamp's beautiful work highlights the coastal landscape of Oceanside.

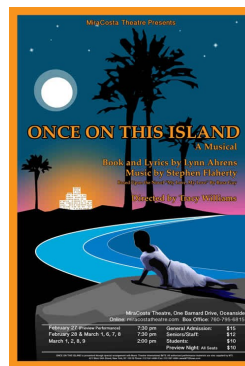
