## Rules and Regulations

Please pay special attention to instructions on each ticket machine. Place your parking permit on the vehicle dash face up only.

- Do NOT park in intersections and crosswalks, nor on sidewalks, nor blocking any driveway, nor in any manner that obstructs the free use of the street.
- Do NOT park within 15 feet of a fire station driveway or fire hydrant.
- Do NOT park for more than 72 hours in any one spot without moving your vehicle.
- Do NOT park outside of marked parking stalls.
- Do NOT encroach over any "Fire Lane" or red lane markings in any lot.

Your vehicle may be impounded if it is left unattended for more than 72 hours, is unregistered for a period greater than 6 months, is inoperable, or has 5 or more delinquent parking tickets.

### Parking

To ensure that adequate on-street parking is available, time limits have been established for parking on many of Oceanside's downtown, beach and harbor area streets. Please pay special attention to the signs posted on the streets because most time limits are enforced seven days a week, including holidays. All City lots (except those posted as free parking) are self-pay lots. See parking lot map with parking lot information and hours on reverse side of this brochure.

### Parking Structure

The Oceanside Transit Center (OTC) Parking Structure is conveniently located between OTC and the downtown/beach areas. It is open daily between 4:00 am and 2:00 am, and closed between 2:00 am and 4:00 am daily for maintenance. For longer term parking options, please contact OTC at 760-966-6550.

### Annual Beach Permits

The Annual Beach Permit Program allows patrons to park in the beach and harbor pay lots without having to pay the parking fees. Other lot restrictions apply. The cost of the parking permit is \$100 for residents and \$200 for non-residents, and is valid for one year between July 1 and June 30. There are two types of beach permits offered: a transferable rearview mirror hanging parking permit and a permanent parking decal. For more information, call 760-435-4500.

### 24-Hour Lots

#### Beach Lots

**Beach Lots 24A and 24B.** Parking receipts run from midnight to midnight no matter what time purchased.

**Beach Lot 26.** Day rate and night rate; see reverse for details.

**Harbor Lots** Harbor Lot 11 closes at 8:00 pm. The remainder of the harbor lots are open 24 hours a day with the following restrictions:

**Harbor Lot 11A.** Parking is restricted to allow only vehicles with boat trailers.

**Harbor Lot 11B.** This is a multi-use lot for larger vehicles such as recreational vehicles and vehicles with trailers, and these vehicles may park in the center spaces.

**Harbor Lot 12.** Open 24 hours a day September 16 to May 14 only. This is a multi-use lot that permits parking of standard size vehicles and motor homes not to exceed 26 feet in length.

### Camping

Camping is not allowed on the beach or in any other public place with the exception of contained vehicle camping in Harbor Lots 11B and 12 (during the times of operation), and Lot 11A in the spaces marked off in the northeast corner of the lot and with a boat trailer only. Lots are self-payment with pay receipts and with payment options for multiple day and night stays.

### Slip Renter Permits

Vehicles utilizing Slip Renter permit parking spaces must have a parking permit from the Harbor Office. Vehicles not displaying proper permits are subject to citation.

### Lot Closures

The City does close the following lots at night: Harbor Lot 11; Pier and Beaches Lots 21, 22, 27, 28, 29, 30 and 31. See reverse for details.

### Alcohol

No possession of or drinking of alcohol is permitted on the beach, the Pier, The Strand, Pier Plaza area, amphitheater, Strand Beach Park, Tyson Street Park or in any of the parking lots at the The Strand or in the Oceanside Small Craft Harbor.

### Smoking

Smoking is prohibited in parks, beaches, the Pier and the amphitheater.

### Beach Fires

Beach fires are permitted only within City fire rings. No burning of pallets, tires, painted or treated wood, Christmas trees, green wood, trash or any other material that would cause a concern for health or safety. Rings are closed from 11:00 pm to 6:00 am except on Harbor Beach.

### Dogs

No dogs are allowed on the beach parks, the sand, the Pier or in the ocean. You may walk your dog on a leash on The Strand; however, you must be responsible for picking up your dog waste.

### Glass Containers

No glass containers are permitted on the beach, the Pier or any public park or playground.

### Unnecessary Noise

It is unlawful for any person to make any loud unnecessary or unusual noise, or any noise which either annoys, disturbs, injures or endangers the comfort, health, peace or safety of others within the City. Loud radios, stereos, speakers and boom boxes are subject to confiscation. In the Harbor, generators must be turned off between 10:00 pm and 7:00 am.

## Oceanside Harbor

- The Harbor has many amenities including the Oceanside Marina Suites and a variety of shops.
- You can sail, spend the day on a deep-sea fishing boat, whale watch, rent kayaks or visit the marina. Fishing is an option from the jetties. There is no charge for using the launching ramp.
- Harbor Beach is Oceanside's largest beach, offering everything from surfing to volleyball.
- Harbor Beach has three lifeguard towers, picnic tables, barbecue grills, gazebos, showers and 24 fire rings.
- There are restrooms and telephones, a shack bar and some volleyball courts (you supply the net and ball).
